

The art documentary featuring Kinan and his fellow artists forms an emotional and artistic tribute, offering a captivating portrayal of artists dedicated to telling their own stories. It reshapes the narrative of contemporary Syria, serving as an ode to cherished memories and enduring love, despite the profound losses and wounds inflicted by war and conflict.



Director's Note

This film constitutes the third installment in my Silk Road series consisting of four feature length documentary films, exploring the disappearance of cultural traditions. The central inquiry into the future without these essential elements remains paramount in my exploration. Since my initial encounter with Kinan Azmeh in 2010, my desire to collaborate with him has only deepened. Based in New York, Kinan grapples with the war that severs his ties to Syria, intensifying his inner quest to understand his roots and weave them into his musical creations. Beyond a personal journey, this film serves as my exploration into the origins of our civilization. In an era of divisive wars and political agendas, where diaspora fosters discrimination and extremism instills deep societal fears, I firmly believe that only reciprocal cultural understanding and respect can reunite us. This film aspires not only to pay homage to our shared cultures and heritages but, above all, to humbly become an emotional and artistic tribute to cherished memories and enduring love. Kinan's desire to reshape the narratives of Syria through music remains a crucial thread in this poignant exploration, despite the profound weight of loss and wounds inflicted by wars and conflicts.





Frank Scheffer directed over 40 music documentaries and experimental films. He has received many awards and was honored with a retrospective at the MoMA New York. He works with the prominent post-war composers like Luciano Berio, Pierre Boulez, John Cage, Elliott Carter, Karlheinz Stockhausen and Frank Zappa. In his films, image and sound orchestrate to offer the audience a unique visual and audial experience. *The One All Alone* (2009) premiered in Venice 2010. The first film of his 'Silk Road' series *Gozaran, time passing* (filmed in Iran) premiered at IDFA 2011. His film about the Dutch painter Robert Zandvliet *the Perception* (premiere at IFFR2016) won the KNF award. Frank's last and the second of his "Silk Road" series. *The Inner Landscape* (2019) portraits the Chinese composer Guo Wenjing and the fate of traditional art in modern China. The film had its world-premiere at IFFR2019 as its closing film.
